**MEMBERS ONLY FISHING CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Muskie must be caught on legal sport fishing tackle (hook & line) in the United States or Canada in strict compliance with all local, state or provincial laws. Release Division: 30 inch minimum. Kept Division: That length set by the governing agency of that body of water.
2. Muskie must be hooked and played by only one person, and that person may enter the muskie in the contest.
3. Entrant must be a member in good standing of Muskies, Inc., prior to catching the fish.
4. All entries must be mailed to the chapter contest chairman and postmarked within 30 days of the date of the catch. The chapter chairman will mail all entries to the international chairman twice monthly or enter them directly to the Lunge Log on the Muskies, Inc., web site by the Internet. All entries for Nov. and Dec. must be received by the international chairman by Jan. 10. Unaffiliated members should mail their entries to the international chairman within 30 days of the catch. 5. Release Division: 30-inch minimum for all bodies of water. It is the policy of Muskies, Inc. to encourage our members to release any healthy muskie that is not a true trophy to them. Accordingly a release patch and/or an individual certificate will be awarded for each muskie 30-inches or longer that is released alive. Please indicate your desire to receive these on the front of the entry form. An annual certificate, that states the total released for a one year period is also available.
- 5A. *The longest muskie released in the men's division, women's division and the junior division will receive a free replica mounting of their muskie courtesy of Lax Taxidermy Of Conover, Wi. This is the longest and by total inches including fraction of inches. At least one verifiable witness and at least one verifiable side view horizontal photograph of the muskie is required. Ties will be settled by a coin-flip. This will be presented at the international annual awards banquet each year.*
6. International Weight Division: Men and Women-10 awards, 25 lbs. Minimum. Juniors-10 awards, 20 lb minimum.
7. The international contest committee will review all entries for validity and their decisions will be final. At its discretion the committee may require additional documentation consisting of a photograph and/or a 2<sup>nd</sup> witness before and entry is accepted.
